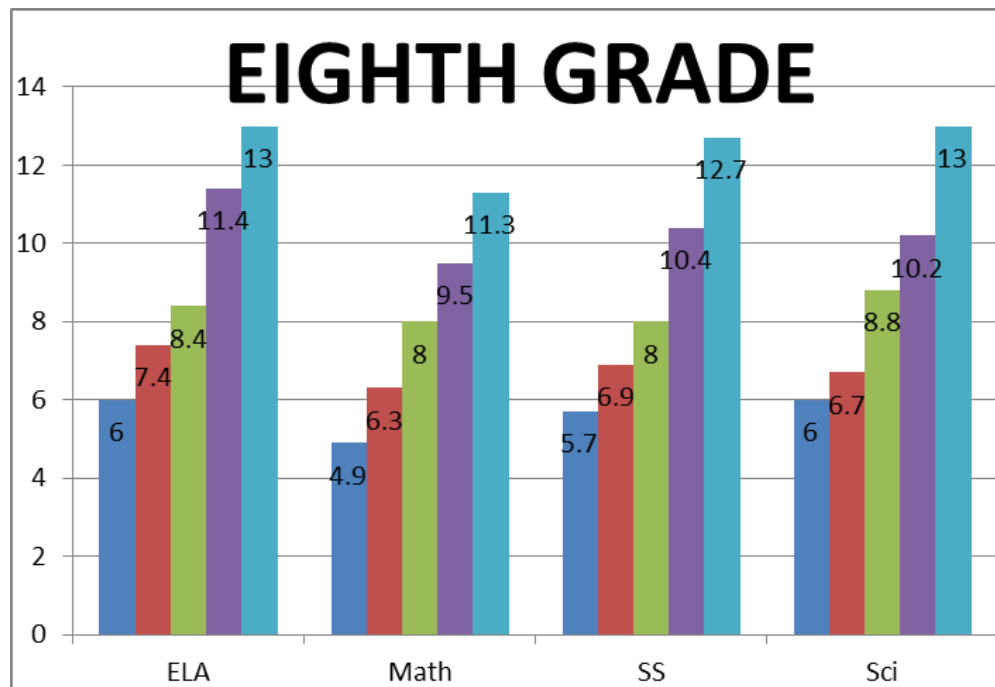


MISSION STATEMENT

Thanks to the parents who attended the PTO meeting on Tuesday. During this meeting, Mrs. Haas presented IOWA scores and plans for the coming 2017-2018 school year. The information will be included in the next few editions of the Eagle's Eye for those who missed it. Additionally, parents of students in grades 2-8 will find their child's IOWA score reports included in white envelopes today. The graphs below show the longitudinal growth for our middle school grades across subject areas. The bars reflect the grade equivalent scores of this same group of students over the past several years. Our goal is a minimum of 1.0 to 1.5 years of growth in each subject area annually.

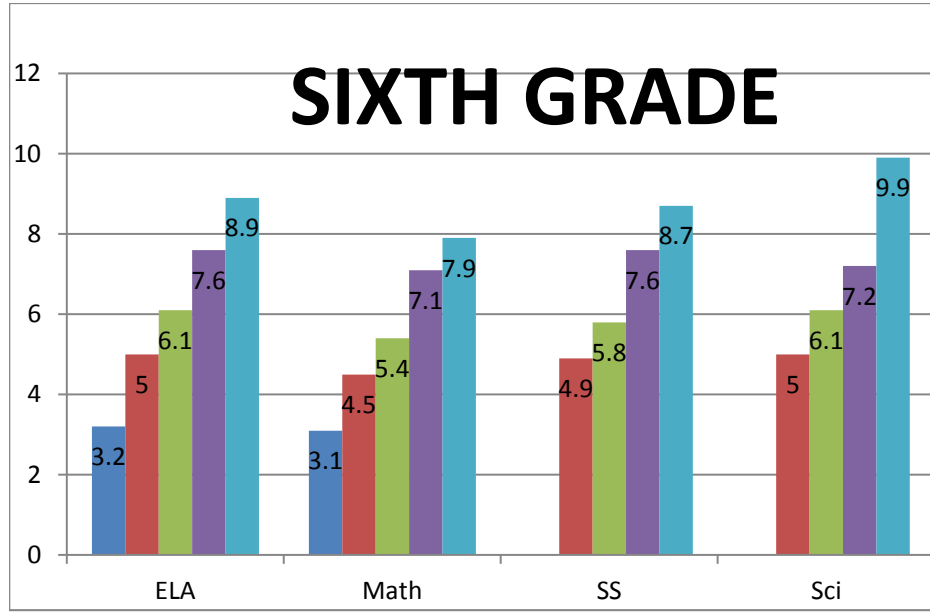
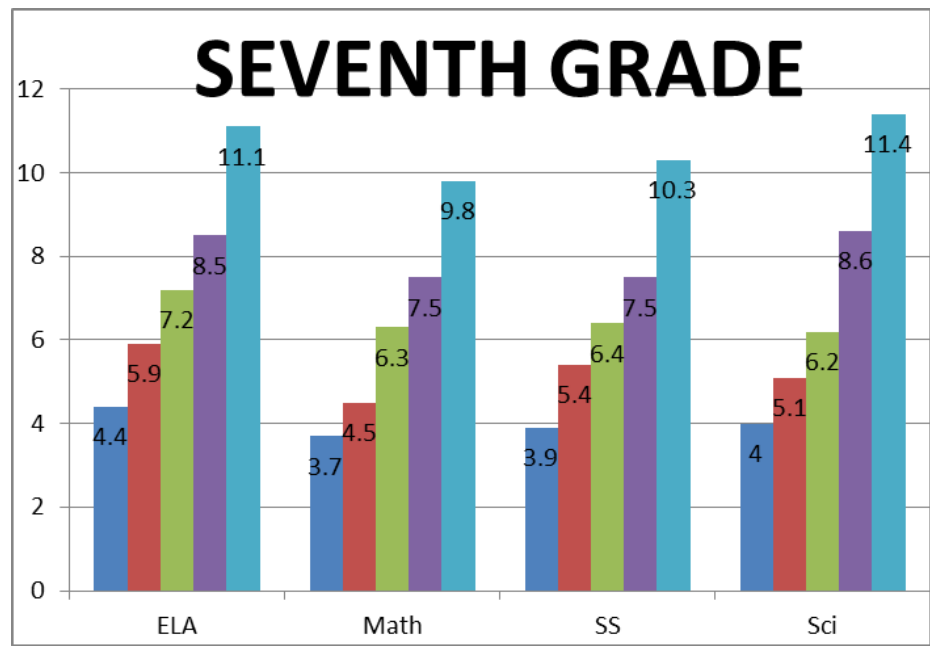

Interpreting Your Child's Iowa Scores

- Parent report shows Percentile Rank.
- 74th Percentile does NOT mean your child scored 74% correct on the test. 50th Percentile is national average. Anything above 50th percentile is in the top half of the nation.
- There are occasions where the percentile rank goes down but the child shows a year or more of growth. If you are concerned, please reach out to your child's teacher who can get more information for you. Still have question? Contact Mrs. Estevez, guidance counselor or your child's teacher.

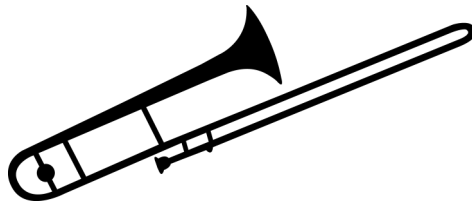
Shredding to Benefit Catholic Charities
